### **SWEARING-IN CEREMONY AT NOON ON NEW YEAR'S DAY: Dozens of elected officials scheduled to take Oath of Office**

**Houston, TX** – Dozens of elected officials will take the Oath of Office at the Harris County Swearing-In Ceremony on January 1, 2015, at noon. The ceremony will take place at the historic 1910 Courthouse, 301 Fannin Street, in the First Court of Appeals Courtroom located on the second floor.



**“Every Elected Official, at the beginning of their term of office, is required by law to take the official Oath of Office before executing their official duties,”** said Harris County Clerk Stan Stanart. **“This ceremony also declares the commitment of the Elected Official to serve the citizens of Harris County.”**

**County Judge Ed Emmett will be the featured speaker** giving his charge to the newly elected officials. As Clerk of Harris County and Chief Elections Officer of Harris County, Stanart will serve as the master of ceremonies and conduct the formal Swearing-In for the newly elected officials.

According to Stanart, plenty of parking should be available for the event. Complimentary parking will be available in the Congress Plaza Garage, 1019 Congress Street. Moreover, per the city of Houston Parking Management, street parking is free on New Year's Day.

**“This ceremony provides elected officials and their family members and friends the opportunity to celebrate the final result of the elections process in the hallowed atmosphere of a building that has been the scene of many significant events in Harris County for over a hundred years,”** concluded Stanart.
